

## RECORDS OF ENDURING VALUE

For general information, the following is a working list of the types of state and local records the State Archivist has identified as having enduring value to the public. These public records should never be destroyed and once they have become inactive (not of the current year or referenced on an average of once a month or more) they should be transferred to the State Archives. This list is not complete as new types of records are being created daily and not all of early Idaho record series have been identified. Before any public official authorizes the destruction of any record, the Idaho State Historical Society should be contacted to make sure the record in question does not have enduring value.
